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### **Call for Applications for the Ph.D. Programme**

INCOIS is a leading institute in the field of operational Oceanography with a specific objective to provide oceanographic information and advisories to public and other stake holders. The services of INCOIS are supported by focused in-house research and development activities. INCOIS has research collaborations with several national and international oceanographic institutes. Major research activities in INCOIS include ocean modelling, ocean data assimilation, studies in physical, chemical, and biological oceanography, marine biogeochemistry, satellite oceanography, remote sensing and GIS applications in oceanography, coastal vulnerability studies, potential fishing zone identification and studies related to water quality, tsunami and storm surges. INCOIS is the National Oceanographic Data Centre which collects/gathers and archives large amount of oceanographic data, that are vital for operational and research activities. INCOIS possesses world class research infrastructure that includes state-of-the-art high-performance computer, wet and dry labs and a well-equipped library. International Training Centre for Operational Oceanography (ITCOcean), established at INCOIS has been recognized as a Category-2 Centre by UNESCO.

INCOIS is a recognized research centre of Hyderabad Central University, Andhra University, Mangalore University and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University (Hyderabad). INCOIS also operates a joint research centre along with Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies in KUFOS campus. More details about INCOIS are available at <https://www.incois.gov.in>. INCOIS invites applications for Ph.D. programme from motivated candidates with a first class M.Sc./M.Tech. in Marine Sciences/ Oceanography/ Atmospheric Sciences/ Earth Sciences/ Meteorology/ Physics/ Mathematics. Candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by CSIR/UGC/DBT/DST or GATE or should have provisionally selected for INSPIRE Ph. D. fellowship. Candidates who have cleared the UGC-CSIR NET (LS) without fellowship, if selected, will be offered fellowship from INCOIS as per INCOIS norms. Selected candidates should register for Ph.D. on a specific topic with one of the recognized universities within two years of joining under the guidance of the scientists of INCOIS.

Interviews of shortlisted candidates will be conducted twice in a year (May/June and October/November). Applications received during 1 October to 30 April will be considered for the interview in May/June and the applications received during 1 May to 30 September will be considered for the interview in October-November. Final selection of the Ph.D. candidates will be based on personal interview conducted at INCOIS. Candidates whose final results are awaited, but who are otherwise eligible above criteria, can also apply. However, the candidate will have to produce provisional/original certificate and marksheets of qualifying exam at the time of interview.
